In this update we set out the themes which will guide our work during the period from September 2022 to January 2023.



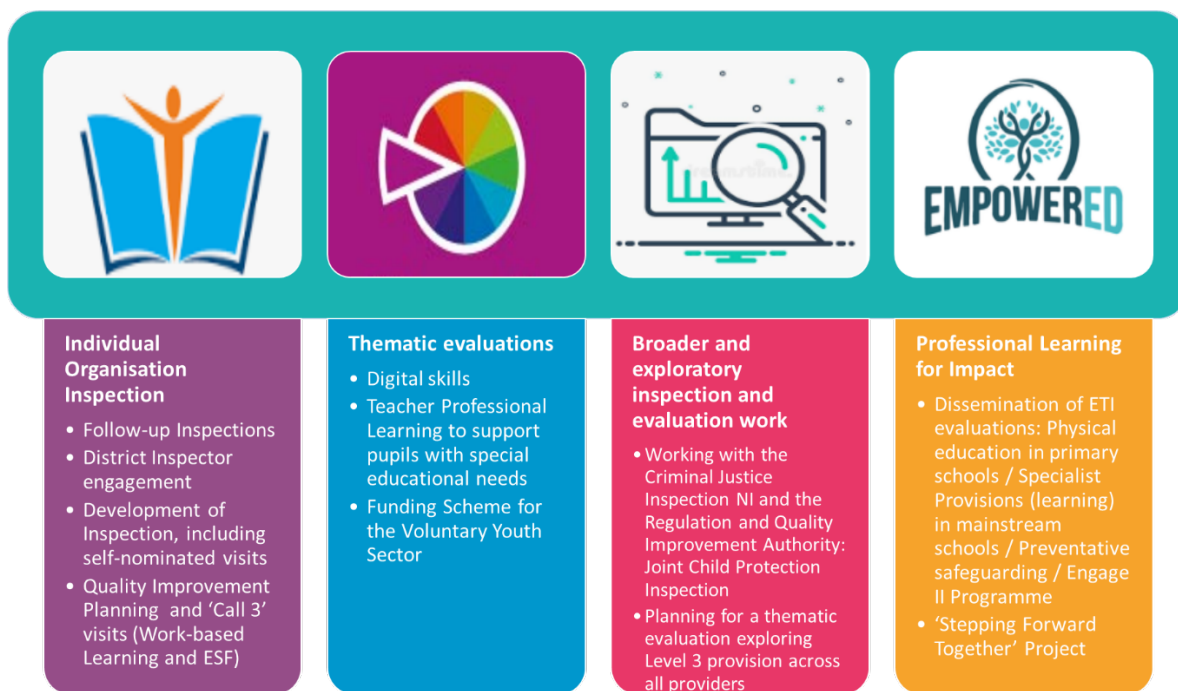

The strategy incorporates four interrelated strands as shown below.
