## THE QUALITY OF PROVISION FOR CHILDREN IN THE AUTISM SPECIFIC CLASS IN THE ARMSTRONG PRIMARY SCHOOL, ARMAGH (501-1115)

The Education and Training Inspectorate carried out an inspection in The Armstrong Primary School, Armagh in May 2007. The strengths and area for development were identified as follows.

#### Strengths identified include:

- the well-settled classroom routine, reflecting the hard work and commitment of the teacher and classroom assistants to the needs of the children;
- the teacher's developing expertise and completion of a range of relevant training courses;
- the good use of visual materials and autism specific strategies which are focused appropriately on promoting the children's learning and social behaviour; the children make good progress as a consequence; and
- the effective policy and procedures in place, including the planned integration opportunities.

#### Area for development:

• the need to involve further the parents in the work of the class and extending, as needed, the autism specific strategies into the home.

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
