The Education and Training Inspectorate (Inspectorate) carried out an inspection as part of the above survey in Rainey Endowed School, Magherafelt on 12 January 2010.

The school has identified appropriate and measurable targets for improvement to demonstrate:

- that mathematics is an area of clear curricular strength, which has rising levels of attainment;
- how the strengths in mathematics have the potential to promote quality teaching and learning and whole-school development;
- how they will use mathematics to develop existing links with other schools, and the wider community; and
- viable financial planning to allocate funding.

For the purpose of showing improvement more clearly the school has reviewed and revised appropriately the targets set for mathematics and at whole-school level.

The Inspectorate will continue to monitor the work of the school as part of the Specialist Schools' project.
